TECHBOARD	Embossed absorbent top layer coupled with Kraft backing. Most economical and commonly liner used. Used for rodents, chickens or birds when cages are changed daily.
TECHBOARD K52	Embossed absorbent top layer coupled with “wet strength” backing. Provides for extended use. Used for diabetic rats and other rodents, and will extend time between changes.
TECHBOARD II	Heavier, embossed absorbent top layer coupled with “wet strength” backing. Will allow for less frequent changes when used for high-output animals or those that play with their water valves or bottles. Used for guinea pigs, rabbits, diabetic rats, and other rodents.
SHEPSORB	Single ply embossed absorbent sheet. Commonly used for rodents and birds. Used when liner is changed daily.
TECHSORB	Single ply, highly absorbent white liner. Primarily used for rabbits, guinea pigs, ferrets, primates, and other high urine output animals. White color aids in the observation of discharges.
POLY PADS	Poly Pads are ideal for cage liners, necropsy liners, and pads for animal post-surgical recovery areas. Poly Pads are multilayered white tissue with a poly backing, providing increased absorbency and liquid control. Poly Pads can soak up heavy discharge from large animals such as rabbits, guinea pigs, and ferrets.
DURA PADS	Dura Pads are multi-layered white tissue combined with embossed paper for higher absorbency. Ideal for cage liners. Dura Pads can soak up heavy discharge from animals such as rabbits, guinea pigs, and ferrets.
